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## Scope of Work & Responsibilty

Work covered in this tender document shall generally be as detailed herein below. However, contractor shall  $\frac{1}{Page}$ be responsible to complete the work in all respects and in doing so provide/supply all facilities which may not be covered below but nevertheless are required to complete the work envisaged with the exception of only such items as have been specifically excluded from contractor's scope.

The successful tenderer shall have to undertake the following work:

The tender is meant for undertaking & executing all works through various steps of works/jobs as briefed in BOQ. All job needs to be undertaken complying the BOQ specifications, Technical Specifications, Safety Clause and General Terms & Conditions mentioned in the NIT/Tender Document.

The Scope of work of this tender consists of providing material, equipment, plant & machinery, labour, transport, tools and tackles, required services etc for the above mentioned subject works , at our Container Freight Station, as described in condition of contract, Priced schedule and as mentioned elsewhere in this tender.

Supply & Erection of MS Structural Weigh Bridge Platform In replacement of The existing one, Including Design, Engineering & Fabrication for a Sartorious Make 80MT Pit Mounted Weigh Bridge of Size 3m X 16m, at Gate-1 of CFS-Kolkata. Job to comply with Technical Specifications, Scope of Work Safety Clause, Recommended make etc as detailed above. Weight of newly supplied structural platform shall not less than 11(eleven) Ton(Metric Ton). For more details refer Price Schedule(BOQ) below.

Work shall also include dismantling of the existing structural platform and include Testing, Verification and Stamping by Legal Metrology

## **TECHINICAL SPECIFICATION COMPLIANCE**

- 1. Pit-mounted platform size: 16mx3m, Sartorius make having 8 No. 50t Load Cells
- 2. Structure should 100% match with the existing civil foundation for load cells and other accessories
- 3. Platform drawing should be approved by OEM (Sartorius) so that overall performance of the WB is not affected with new platform
- 4. Dead load of platform should be 11 MT +
- 5. Downtime allowable 10 days.

#### Recommended brand of materials:

- Steel member shall be of SAIL/TISCO/JINDAL.
- .Cement to used for civil & masonary work as may be required for repair maintenance works shall be ACC/ULTRATECH/ LAFARGE/ GRASHIM or equivalent & approved make.

### **VENDOR'S SCOPE OF SUPPLY AND WORK**

The above work will be taken up on Turnkey Contract basis, including Designing, Engineering,

Fabrication with supply of all materials, tools & machineries, manpower and transportation of materials EXCEPTING what has been covered under BL's scope of supply/work as under.

- Dead Load beyond Standard Weights to be brought by Vendor as per norms of Weights & Measures , Legal Metrology, Govt. of West Bengal.
- Necessary repair/modification of the base civil foundation etc. to be done by successful vendor at their Page | 8 cost and no extra amount shall be charged by them.
- Vendor shall provide non-slip strips on top of the platform, Knife-edges, Bearings and Up-pull links etc. complete.
- Complete Verification, Testing and Stamping including liaison with Legal Metrology for Weights & Measures, Govt. of West Bengal.
- Provide required skilled/unskilled labour, materials and Test Weights of 20MT with transportation etc. all complete to undertake & install & commissioning of the modified Weigh Bridge.

### **BALMER LAWRIE'S SCOPE OF SUPPLY & WORK**

- Handling Equipment/ Crane facility for heavy materials handling/installation/lifting etc.
- Free Electricity and water as would be required for execution of the job.
- Any unusable materials generated out of the dismantling of the existing of existing WB PLATFORM is the property of BL. Vendor may opt for Buyback of the steel as per their price rate to be quoted as per item-2 in Price Schedule.

## SAFETY CLAUSE

- A. a) The contractor and his workers must strictly take all safety precautions and shall supply to his workers dependable safety appliances like hand gloves, safety boots, safety belt, safety helmets, duster cloth, dust mask/nostril filter etc. In addition to this, contractor shall also provide additional safety appliances as per requirement and follow safe working practices like using fully insulated electrode holders etc. He shall also ensure that his workmen intelligently use only dependable safety appliances supplied to them.
  - b) The contractor shall take adequate safety precaution to prevent accidents at site. The contractor shall also ensure that his employees observe the statutory safety rules and regulations and also those laid down by the employer from time to time and promptly submit report of accident and state the measures taken by him to prevent their recurrence and also keep the employer indemnified of all claims arising out of such accidents.
  - c) No Workmen shall be engaged on the work without proper safety induction and without using required PPE. Use of safety helmet and shoe is must excepting in painting works where shoe will not be used.
  - d) All workmen employed within Balmer Lawrie site should be in sound and intoxicated health condition. Balmer Lawrie may ask for a health certificate of any workmen employed by Contractor at site anytime before/during/after execution of job at site.

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#### MODE OF DEDUCTION OF PENALTY

- 1. In case of Minor violation and every subsequent violation a sum of Rs.500/- and Rs.1000/respectively (Limited to 10% of contract value) will be deducted from the bill of the contractor as
  penalty on the direction of Executing Authority to the Finance Deptt for deduction from the
  bill/Security Deposit of the contractor & Safety Officer/Unit HR Head will be intimated.
- 2. In case of major violation a sum of Rs.5000/- for 1<sup>st</sup> violation & Rs.10,000/- for every subsequent violation (Limited to 10% of contract value) will be imposed by Executing Authority within 3 days of violation and direct Finance Deptt for deduction from the bill/Security Deposit of the contractor accordingly & Safety Officer/ Unit HR Head will be intimated.
- 3. In case of violation leading to fatality / permanent disability, the Unit Head will impose fine of Rs.1,00,000/2,00,000 (Depending on the case) or 10% of the contract value whichever is lower on the contractor. ## **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### 1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID

- a) Payment of Interest Free EMD of Rs. [10,000/-]. However, MSME/NSIC bidders are exempted from submission of EMD.
- b) Have full fledged Office Set up at Kolkata with Vat/Service Tax Registration.
- c) Owned Service Set-up/reputed service dealer at Kolkata.
- d) Should have minimum Average Financial Turnover of Rs. [4 Lacs per year during the last 3 financial years.]
- e) The Bidder should have successfully executed similar works / related civil works of cost not less than any of the following values during past five years ending 31st March, 2017:
  - i. 3 jobs each of value not less than 4.0 Lakhs
  - ii. 2 jobs each of value not less than 6.0 lakhs
  - iii. 1 job of value not less than 10.0 lakhs

Documentary evidence to be uploaded/submitted.

- f) The bidder must have PF registration.
- g) The bidder must have ESI registration.
- h) The bidder should not have been black listed in any of the PSU's or private organizations and a self-certification to this affect would need to provided on contractor's letter head.

#### 2. SUBMISSION OF ONLINE BIDS

The bids should be submitted in 2[two] separate parts titled as

[A] Technical / Commercial Bid [Unpriced]

and

[B] Price Bid

For Price Bid, only the rates are to be submitted as per given format.

The entire bid is to have digital signature of the person having Power of Attorney/Power of Authority to sign on behalf of the Bidder.

#### 3. TENDER OPENING

[A] Unpriced [Technical-Commercial] Bid Opening

Technical / Commercial Bids will be opened online as per the Tender Calendar.

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[B] Price Bid Opening.

### 4. ACCEPTANCE OF OFFERS

- 4.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part or reject any tender or all tenders or place order for any quantity, less than or more than the tendered quantity, without assigning any reason thereof.
- 4.2 Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest is detected between the bidders and Balmer Lawrie at any stage.
- 4.3 Balmer Lawrie would like to place order for all the items of work as mentioned in the Price bid to a single contractor. The overall L-1 status will be determined by looking at the total value quoted by the bidder based on the estimate quantity against a line item as given in the tender document multiplied by the rate quoted by the bidder.
- 4.5 Balmer Lawrie also reserves its right to allow Public Enterprises (Central / State) price / purchase / contract / service preference as admissible under the existing Government policy. The decision of Balmer Lawrie in this connection will be final.
- 4.6 Incomplete tenders, conditional tenders, tenders received late or tender not conforming to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender documents or not accompanied by the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (unless exempted under the terms of this Tender) will be rejected.

## 5. **NEGOTIATIONS**

- a. Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to negotiate with the Tenderer. Tenderer will have to attend the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie for negotiations/clarifications required from them, in respect of their quotations, without any commitment on the part of Balmer Lawrie.
- b. In case of negotiation, the Tenderer should send the confirmation of outcome of such negotiation in writing so as to reach the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie within 3 days from the date of negotiation/ the time stipulated whichever is earlier. If the Tenderer fails to comply with this requirement Balmer Lawrie reserves its right to ignore their quotation at its discretion and proceed to finalise the tender.

#### 6. PRICE VARIATION

6.1 The price should be firm and irrevocable and not subject to any change whatsoever even due to

increase in cost of materials, components and labour cost till the validity of the contract period.

6.2 The quoted rates shall be kept valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 120 days from the last date for submission of tender.

#### 7. NOTIFICATION OF AWARD

Prior to the expiration of the period of Bid validity, BL will place purchase/work order or letter of intent on the successful bidder(s).

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#### 8. SITE VISIT.

The Tenderer, at the Tenderer's own cost/responsibility is advised to visit and examine the Site of Work and its surroundings and obtain all information that may be necessary for preparing the Tender for entering into a contract, for execution of the work.

## 9. SECURITY DEPOSIT / EMD

The bidder should submit Earnest Money of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) in the form of Pay Order/Demand Draft drawn in favour of BALMER LAWRIE & CO. LTD. payable at Kolkata. In case bidder revokes or withdraws its offer within validity of the offer or fails to submit security deposit and/or commence the work after the contract is awarded, Balmer Lawrie will be at liberty to forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit. EMD of unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded without interest after finalisation of the contract. However, EMD of successful bidder shall be retained as Security Deposit till the completion of the contract/job. The Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited or appropriated towards any penalty imposed by BL as a result of acts of omission/commission/gross negligence on the part of the contractor or towards any charges like demurrage, damage to the container/cargo that may become payable by Balmer Lawrie to its customers or failure of the successful bidder to execute the work as per terms and conditions of the contract without prejudice to the other right or action that the Company is entitled to. The Security Deposit after adjustment, if any, may be refunded to the contractor after successful completion of the contract and after settlement of all dues. No interest shall be payable on the security deposit.

## **10. RATE**

Rates to be quoted as per Price Bid Schedule attached. Rates should be inclusive of providing materials, labour costs, fabrication, tools and tackles, transport costs etc as required and rates to be quoted shall be **inclusive of all duties & charges except for Service Tax** (if any ) which shall be paid by BL extra as applicable. The rate should be kept firm during the period of contract. No additional charges of any nature would be paid by Balmer Lawrie & Co Ltd over and above the quoted rate.

#### **11. PAYMENT TERMS:**

- **70**% of Purchase Order value shall be paid on receipt of the materials along with all structural steel etc.
- **20%** shall be released after due Installation, Commissioning, Certification & Stamping by Statutory Authority(i.e Legal Metrology)

and

• Balance 10% shall be retained by us for one year as Retention Money for Warranty/Defect Liability Period. However, the same may be released against Performance Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount.

#### 12. COMPLETION PERIOD

The entire work shall be completed within **12 weeks** from the date of awarding the job. Out of 12 weeks tentatively 10 weeks is for supply of Fabricated Structural new Platform at site and a total of 10 days Dismantling of old platform, installation of new platform (i.e. a maximum of 10days down time) from handing over the site. Time is the essence of the contract.

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#### 13. INSURANCE

The contractor should take necessary insurance for their technicians and labourers who will be working within the BL premises for fabrication , erection of the tower and allied jobs. A copy of such policy is required to be provided to BL-CFS.

### 14. LABOUR LAW

The Contractor shall comply with all the provisions of all labour legislations of the State/Central Government or any competent authority as applicable in respect of all men/women employed by them in executing the contract. The contractor shall be responsible to defend cost and expenses whatsoever arising out of any failure on the part of contractor to comply with all or any of the Acts and Regulations, of all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, cost and expenses whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the matters referred to in this tender. Coverage of ESIC/WC for operator/helper to be undertaken by contractor copy of which is to be provided to BL-CFS, failing which BL will deduct at the applicable rate of ESI contribution from contractor's bill and the same will be deposited with the concerned Authority.

Contractor shall be responsible to settle all the disputes with Workmen engaged by them. Contractor shall indemnify and absolve the Company of all responsibilities related to employment condition of their employees and should adequately safeguard Company against any possible IR problems including related to employment. Notwithstanding the above the contractor should adhere to all employment regulations such as Minimum Wage Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, Provident Fund Act, Gratuity Act, Employees State Insurance Act, Bonus Act, etc.

The Company will not have any liability towards employment, remuneration or compensation in whatsoever manner against demand made by the employees of the contractor and such demand be settled by the contractor directly.

Contractor will ensure that the services rendered is discharged without any hindrance and blockage and no other charges/demand for payment are levied on the Company for the services rendered other than the fixed rates as covered in this tender.

#### 15. COMPENSATION FOR DELAY

- (i) In the case of delay in completion of the total job by reason of contractor's fault, the Contractor shall pay compensation to the Owner @ **0.5**% of the total phase wise value for every week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of **10**% of the total Contract value. The penalty will be calculated phase-wise.
- (ii) Notwithstanding what is stated in Clause above, the Owner shall have the right to employ any other agency to complete the remaining work at the risk and cost of the Contractor, in the event of his failing to complete the work within the stipulated time.

#### 16. FORCE MAJEURE CONDITIONS:

Delivery schedule is subject to force majeure conditions as under: If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock outs or acts of God (hereinafter referred as "events") provided notice of the happening of any such events is given by either party to the other within twenty one days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance. Deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable.

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#### 17. ARBITRATION

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred for adjudication at Chennai to a Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman & Managing Director, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. and the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the Arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties.

#### 18. ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENT

In absence of the timely and proper performance by the contractor, BL reserves the right to utilize the services of any other contractor without notice at the <u>risk and cost</u> of the contractor and to recover charges and expenses in excess of the contractual terms from the contractor. Similarly if the contractor fails to meet their contractual obligations, the work shall be completed at their risk and cost through alternative sources/arrangements. This will be without prejudice to the rights of BL for any other action including termination, forfeiture of security deposit etc.
