1. Introduction

All Bids are to be completed and returned in accordance with tender requirements within the tender due date as mentioned.

The bidders are requested to bid online within the tender announcement date and tender closing date and time as mentioned in the tender document.

The term <u>"BL"</u> wherever mentioned in the tender document refers to <u>"Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd."</u>. BL would be the Purchaser/Owner for the tendered item.

The successful bidder will be the Supplier.

This document is the Tender.

The Acceptance of the Order by the successful bidder will form the contract.

5. Bid Security / Earnest Money Deposit(EMD)/ Bid Bond – As per Clause no. 1 & 3 of the Special Terms & Conditions of this Tender document.

If any of the documents furnished by the bidder is found to be false / fabricated, the bidder is liable for black listing, forfeiture of the EMD, cancellation of work and criminal prosecution.

Unless otherwise agreed to in terms of the Purchase Order, the price shall be : Firm till execution of entire contract.

6. Corrigendum to tender:

The bidder has to keep track of any changes by viewing the addendum / Corrigendum's issued by the Tender Inviting Authority on time-to- time basis in the E-Procurement platform/ newspapers. The Company calling for tenders shall not be responsible for any claims/problems arising out of this.

The bidder is expected to examine the Tender documents, including all instructions, forms, General Terms & Conditions, Special Terms & Conditions, Technical Specifications and other documents and to fully familiarize itself with the requirements of the bidding documents. Failure to furnish all the information required by the Bidding Documents or the submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect may result in the rejection of the Bid.

8. Late Bids

No bidding is admissible in the E.Proc platform after the bid closing date.

9. Bid Validity

The offer shall remain valid for a period of **three months** from the date of opening of the Price Bid which will be normally one month from opening of Technical Bid.

10. Bid Rejection Criteria

A bid may be rejected if

- i. If the bidder fails to send the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/Bid Bond amount within the bid due date.
- ii. If the bidder does not submit the supporting documents specified.
- iii. The deviations from the terms mentioned in the document affects in any way the scope, quality and performance.
- iv. Conflict of interest between the bidder and the Company is detected at any stage.
- v. Bidders not registered under GST are not eligible for participating in this tender. Bidders to mandatorily provide the Provisional GST Number as per Annexure- II and also provide proof of such registration. Offers received from bidders who are not registered under GST, will not be considered for any evaluation against this tender.

11. Clarifications

Clarifications that the Bidder needs to have on the tender specification can be sought from BL in writing within one week from the date of issue of this enquiry.

All clarifications shall be by e-mail (Only email queries shall be replied)

12. Complete Scope of Supply

The complete scope of supply has been defined in Annexure I of the tender document. Only those bidders who take responsibility and bid for the complete scope of work may be considered for further evaluation.

13. Tender Documents and Deviations

It is expected that bidders will submit bids based strictly on the terms and conditions and specifications contained in the bidding documents and will not stipulate any deviations. Deviation from scope of supply, as given in the Tender Document-Annexure – I, would invite immediate dis-qualification from further consideration of the bid.

14. Language of Bids

The Bid prepared by the bidder, all documents attached to and/or relating to the bid and all correspondence exchanged by the Bidder and BL shall be written in English language only.

Any printed literature furnished by the bidder may be written in any other language provided that this literature is accompanied by an authenticated English translation, in which case, for purpose of interpreting the Bid, the English translation shall govern.

15. Preparation and submission of Tender Documents

The bidders are required to fill the tender document in a format as outlined below in the E.Proc platform:

a. Price Bid (Annexure IV is Price Bid)

The lowest bidder will be decided on the basis of lowest Nett delivered Price for each location in Rupee, for the item mentioned in the scope of supply.

The Price bid should not contain any information other than the price. The price is to be mentioned in both Figures and words and where there is a difference between the two, rate given in words will be taken as authentic.

The quoted price should be firm till the completion of the Order quantity placed on the successful bidder.

Price bid should be filled as per the online Price Bid format provided.

b. After submission of bid online, the bidders are requested to submit the Demand Draft towards EMD alongwith hard copies of other documents which cannot be uploaded as required, to the Tender Inviting Authority before the due date at our Ballard Estate Office at 5,J N Heredia Marg, Ballard Estate, Mumbai – 400 001.

B. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS.

1. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/BID BOND

Earnest Money Deposit Amount to be deposited in the form of Pay order / Demand Draft in Favour of Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd, payable at Mumbai for INR 20000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)

Bidders have to submit Earnest Money Deposit by Demand Draft/Pay order/Bank transfer in favour of Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd., payable at Mumbai, India. The Demand Draft/Pay order has to be made from a Scheduled Indian Bank. The EMD/Bid Bond to be deposited within the Due date for the tender. Earnest Money Deposit can also be made directly to our Standard Chartered Bank (Account No. 222-0-526803-6, NEFT Code - IFSC "SCBL0036046) through electronic transfer and proof of transfer of funds deposited with us.

- a) OFFERS RECEIVED WITHOUT EMD WILL BE REJECTED
- b) For the successful bidder, the EMD will be refunded only after they submit the necessary Security Deposit against the work order placed on them. EMD will carry no interest.
- c) For the unsuccessful bidders, the EMD will be refunded only after the successful bidder has accepted the Purchase order and the acknowledgement of the same has been received by BL.
- d) Linking of EMD amount with earlier transactions / adjustments with pending bills or any other amount payable by the company is not allowed.

2. EMD is liable to forfeiture in the event of:

- a) Withdrawal of offers during validity period of the offer
- b) Non acceptance of orders by the bidder within the stipulated time after placement of LOI / order
- c) Any unilateral revision made by the bidder during the validity period of the offer
- d) Non execution of the prescribed documents after acceptance of the contract
- e) Non submission of Security Deposit.

3. Security Deposit (SD)

Security Deposit amount of 5% of the basic order value to be deposited by the successful Bidder in the form of Pay order / Demand Draft in favour of Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd, payable at Mumbai or Bank Guarantee valid for 18 months in BL's format (Annexure VI) only.

The Security Deposit may be submitted as Bank Guarantee by a Scheduled Indian Bank within 10 days of receipt of the Purchase Order. Security Deposit can also be made directly to our Standard Chartered Bank (Account No. 222-0-526803-6, NEFT Code - IFSC "SCBL0036046) through electronic transfer and proof of transfer of funds deposited with us.

Cheque/Cash or any other forms of payment are not acceptable towards Security Deposit.

- The Security Deposit will not bear any interest.
- Security Deposit is liable for forfeiture, if
 - -Successful bidder fails to provide service as per tendered job during the contract period.
 - -Successful bidder violates the tender condition,
 - -Security Deposit will be refunded only after successful completion of the contract.
 - -If the performance of the bidder is found to be unsatisfactory.
- The Security Deposit amount can be adjusted to the extent of EMD amount for the successful bidder.
- Payment of supply made will be released only after receipt of Security Deposit.

All sums of compensation or other sums of money as determined, if any, payable by the bidder may be deducted from the Security Deposit.

4. Payment Terms:

Our payment terms are as follows:

Payment for the accepted material will be made within 30 days from the date of receipt of the material or bill whichever is later. Payments shall be made from the location of delivery.

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Consignment should be accompanied by valid documents such as Delivery Challan, Tax Invoice under GST. Bills will not be accepted by us for payment without the consignee's acknowledgment in the delivery challans.

5. Bidders not registered under GST are not eligible for participating in this tender. Registered bidders to mandatorily provide the provisional GST Number as per Annexure III and also provide proof of such registration. Offers received from bidders who are not registered under GST, will not be considered for any evaluation against this tender.

6. RISK PURCHASE

In case delivery of material/Service is not effected as per given schedule from time to time, we reserve the right to cancel the order placed on you, and procure the material/Service from any other source and the deduction on account of penalty as well as excess amount to be incurred by us, would be recovered from the party's due payments or security amount held with us.

7. Award of Contract

The order will be split in between the L1 & L2 parties in the ratio of **60:40**, provided the L2 party matches the rates with L1 rates. In case L2 tenderer does not agree to match the rates with L1 rates, then L3 tenderer would be approached to match the L1 rates. In case L2 & L3 tenderers do not agree to match L1, then 100% order will be placed on L1 party. In the event where there is more than one L1 bidder, then the quantity will be distributed equally between the L1 bidders.

As per provision of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, The vendors should confirm their Registration Number along with the name of their Registering Authority. They should also attach a duly self-certified copy (certified by the Chief Executive of the Enterprise) of the valid registration certificate with each invoice against each dispatch of all purchase orders.

" 20% of the tendered quantity shall be reserved for procurement from participating Micro & Small Industries subject to their quoting price within the price within the price band of L-1 +15% and bringing down their price to L-1 price in a situation L-1 price is from someone other than a Micro and small enterprises, the supply shall be shared proportionately (to tendered qty.)

Out of 20% of this quantity, 4% shall be procured from Micro & Small Enterprises owned by SC& ST entrepreneurs provided they meet the tender requirement and L-1 price. In event of failure of such Micro & Small Enterprises to participate in tender process of meet tender requirement and L-1 price this 4% requirement earmarked for Micro & small Enterprises owned by SC/ST shall be met from other Micro & Small Enterprises.

Negotiations, if held, will be only with the lowest bidder.

Probable scenarios for order distribution.

- In an event where L1 bidder is Non MSME and L2 bidder is MSME, L2 bidder will be offered 20% out of the 40% quantity provided L2 party matches L1 price and balance 20% to be distributed equally among L2 bidder and other MSME bidders (if any) provided their (MSME bidders other than L2) price is within the price band of L-1 +15% and bringing down their price to L-1 price.
- In an event where L1 & L2 bidders are Non MSME and L3/L4/L5... bidders are MSME, L2 bidder will be offered 20% out of the 40% quantity provided L2 party matches L1 price and

balance 20% to be distributed equally among MSME bidders (if any) provided their price is within the price band of L-1 +15% and bringing down their price to L-1 price.

- In an event where L1 bidder is MSME and L2 bidder is non MSME, L2 bidder will be offered the 40% quantity provided L2 party matches L1 price
- In the event of a tie at L2 position, both the bidders asked to match the L1 rate for 20% each of the tendered quantity and subject to acceptance by both the L2 bidders. In the event, if either of the L2 bidders refuses to match the L1 rate, the other L2 bidder who accepts the L1 rate, will be eligible for 40% of the quantity.
- 8. The bidders are specifically advised to note that the Company normally would not carry out any negotiations except with such parties who is / are the lowest bidders originally. As such, it would be in the interest of the bidders to quote lowest possible rates.
- 9. The spill over quantity, if any, will be carried forward with mutual consent.
- 10. **Period of Contract** 12 months [Tentatively from January, 2018 to December, 2018]. The quoted price should be firm throughout the contract period, or till the completion of the ordered quantity, whichever is later. The spill over quantity, if any, will be carried forward with mutual consent.

11. Stocks

Successful tenderer shall maintain 1/12th of the tender quantity as stock in their stock point at any point of time at their own cost. BL's official may visit the facility to verify the same.

- 12. The tenderer is expected to quote in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Company. Printed Standard conditions which may accompany the quotation of the tenderer will not be acceptable. It is expected that bidders will submit bids based strictly on the terms and conditions and specifications contained in the bidding documents and will not stipulate any deviations. Deviation from technical specifications, as given in the Tender Document-Annexure I would invite immediate dis-qualification from further consideration of the bid.
- 13. Delivery As per call ups from our various Plants.

14. Tender Evaluation

The tender would be finalized on the basis of Lowest Nett delivered price (NDP) for each location-Annexure IV and as such it would be in the interest of the bidders to quote their most competitive price.

15. Testing / Inspection

- i] Sampling, testing and acceptance of the material supplied shall be carried out in accordance with the procedure prescribed by the company.
- ii] It must be noted that it is not incumbent upon the company to check and test each and every lot of "Label Rings". The Company shall make only random checks in accordance with the inspection procedure. The tenderer should therefore take note of all requirements before submission of tender. The final acceptance/rejection of materials will be decided at the time of actual usage in the

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respective Plant and it will be binding on the part of the bidder to replace the rejected quantity including the quantity used till the time of identification of quality problem.

16. DELIVERY OF "Label Rings"

- i) To our plants at Taloja, Silvassa, Kolkatta, Chennai, Chittoor, & Asaoti.
- ii) Delivery schedule given from time to time for different locations should be adhered to strictly. The supplier shall complete the supplies of ordered quantities within the stipulated period.
- iii) All costs related to unloading & stacking of material at the plant shall be at the supplier account.
- iv) Transit Risk Insurance shall be covered by the bidder from the successful bidder's stock point to BL's plants.

Any failure by the bidder to do so shall place the consignment at the bidder's risk.

- **17.** Tenderer should quote only <u>rate per piece basis</u> and any other basis is not acceptable. Offer from Bidder should contain all the elements such as Basic rates per piece, GST and Freight should be shown separately.
- 18. The company reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part and reject any or all tenders.
- 19. Despatch Instructions

Unless otherwise specifically advised in writing, the goods shall not be despatched without prior receipt of purchase order issued by BL.

20. In case of unsatisfactory performance of the successful tenderer (s) either in relation to quality of material or adherence to delivery schedule, Company reserves its right to cancel part or whole of the order and forfeit such amounts, as the Company may deem reasonable due to the loss of goodwill, business and goods due to such unsatisfactory performance, from the security deposit (s) deposited by the successful bidder.

21. Packing & Marking

The item should be packed to protect from water ingress and should not be exposed to heat. It should be so packed to withstand the hazards normally encountered with the means of transport, including loading and unloading operation. The successful bidder shall be held liable for all damages to the item due to defective or insufficient packing.

C. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Introduction

The bidder means the firm or company with whom the order is placed and shall be deemed to include the bidder, successors, representatives, heirs, executors and administrators. Whenever there is a duplication of clause in the terms and conditions, the clause which is beneficial to BL will be considered applicable at the time of any dispute.

2. Scope of Service

Scope of Service for the tender shall be as mentioned in Annexure III.

3. Reference for Documentation

Work Order Number must appear on all correspondence.

4. Confirmation of Order

The successful bidder shall acknowledge the receipt of work order within 10 days following the mailing of this order in writing or through email and shall thereby confirm his acceptance of purchase order in entirely without exceptions

5. Payment Terms

The terms of payment are as mentioned in Special Terms & Conditions Clause no.4.

6. Rejection of Bids

The bid of any bidder may be rejected if a conflict of interest between the bidder and BL is detected at any state. BL reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part and reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason. The decision of BL in this connection will be final.

7. Delays

7.1 Delay in Bidding

Late tenders / delayed tenders including postal delay and those not conforming to the prescribed terms and conditions will not be considered.

7.2 Delay in Service

The bidder shall try to render service as mentioned in the scope of work within the stipulated time. Delays in Service will attract Liquidated damages as mentioned in Special Terms & Conditions Clause no. 6.

8. The firm has to submit a copy of Entrepreneurs memorandum certificate i.e. EM -Part-issued by District Industries Centre to claim their status as "MICRO" & "SMALL" Entrepreneurs. "SC' & "ST" Entrepreneurs has to submit necessary cast certificate issued by State Authorities.

9. **ARBITRATION**

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of **Kolkata** to a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman & Managing Director, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Limited and the provisions of Arbitration Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment

thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final & binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at **Kolkata** will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract

10. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE

If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions or acts of God (hereinafter referred to as events) then provided notice of the happening any such events if given by either party to the other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof neither party shall be by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damage against the other in respect of such non performance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist and decision of the ED[IP], Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd., as to whether the deliveries has been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any such event for period exceeding 60 days, either party may at its option terminate the agreement.

11. Relaxation of Tender Terms & Conditions

BL reserves the right to relax any of the tender conditions, if necessary, while finalizing the tender at its discretion.

12. Delay in Delivery

The bidder shall try to complete the delivery as mentioned in the scope of work within the stipulated time. Delays in delivery will attract Risk Purchase clause as mentioned in Clause no. 24 of General Terms & Conditions of this tender.

13. Price

The rate given in the offer should be expressed both in words and figures and where there is a difference between the two; rate given in words will be taken as authentic.

Unless otherwise agreed to in terms of the purchase order, the price shall be: Firm and not subject to escalation for any reason whatsoever till execution of entire order.

14.Control Regulations

Successful bidder warrants that all goods/materials covered by this order have been produced, sold, despatched, delivered and furnished in strict compliance with all applicable laws regulations, labour agreement, working conditions and technical codes and statutory requirements as applicable from time to time. All laws and regulations required to be incorporated in executing this tender are hereby deemed to be incorporated by this reference. Owner can disown any responsibility for any irregularity or contravention of any of the statutory regulations in the manufacture or supply of goods covered in

the order. The Bidder shall ensure compliance with the above and shall indemnify tenderer against any actions, damages, costs and expenses of any failure to comply as aforesaid.

15. Termination

Without prejudice to BL's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to BL, BL may terminate the Contract of any part thereof by a written notice to the bidder if:

- The bidder fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- The bidder informs BL of its inability to deliver the item within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- The bidder fails to deliver the item within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace /rectify any rejected or defective material promptly.
- The bidder becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- The bidder makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the bidder.
- The bidder has misrepresented to BL, acting on which misrepresentation, BL has placed the Purchase Order on the bidder.

Upon receipt of said termination notice, the bidder shall immediately discontinue the supply as per the purchase order.

On termination of the contract, without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to BL under the contract, in the event of BL suffering any loss on account of delayed delivery or non-delivery, BL reserves the right to claim and recover damages from the bidder in respect thereof. The EMD / Security Deposit will be forfeited.
