1.2 Digital Certificate authentication

The bidder shall authenticate the bid with his Digital Certificate for submitting the bid electronically on e-procurement platform and the bids not authenticated by digital certificate of the bidder will not be accepted on the e-procurement platform.

All the bidders who do not have digital certificates need to obtain Digital Certificate. They may contact help desk of C1 India Pvt. Ltd.

2. Special Note

- Bids can only be submitted before the last date and time of submission as per the date and time mentioned in the e-tender. Resubmission (if required) of bid should be completed within the stipulated date and time. The system time (IST) that will be displayed on e-tendering web page shall be the time and no other time shall be taken into cognizance.
- Bidders are advised in their own interest to ensure that bids are uploaded and submitted successfully in e-tendering system well before the closing date and time of bid.
- No Printed or posted Bids / offers shall be accepted.
- Balmer Lawrie does not take any responsibility in case bidder fails to upload the documents within specified time of tender submission.
- Balmer Lawrie will not be responsible for any delay under any circumstances for non-receipt of Tenders/ submission of filled in tender documents by due date & time.
- Bidders are requested to provide correct "E-Mail address" and "Mobile No." for receiving updates related to e-tender from time to time.
- The bidder has to keep track of any changes by viewing the Addendum/Corrigendum issued by the Tender Inviting Authority on time-to-time basis in the e-Procurement platform. The Company calling for tenders shall not be responsible for any claims/problems arising out of this.

3. Filling of Tender Documents

- 3.1 The tenderers are requested to carefully study all the tender documents and tender conditions before quoting their rates.
- 3.2 The tender must be strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions and specifications laid out in the tender.
- 3.3 Any terms and conditions given by the tenderer in their offers will not be binding on Balmer Lawrie.
- 3.4 The sole proprietor or authorised representative shall sign all documents that need to be uploaded. When the person signing the documents is not the sole proprietor / authorised representative of the company, the Power of Attorney authorizing such person to act and sign on behalf of the company must be scanned and uploaded and produced later on for verification by Balmer Lawrie.
- 3.5. **Bidder should take print out of price bid schedule , fill the relevant details & upload the same after putting stamp and sign.**

SCOPE OF WORK

From time to time, Balmer Lawrie CFS will be providing the details of longstanding cargo to be auctioned/valued. It would be the responsibility of the selected tenderer to give the proposed e-Auction and Tender cum e-Auction wide publicity through advertisement in leading newspapers at their cost. The tenderer would also be required to prepare the tender documents for the Tender cum e-Auction containing general and special terms and conditions as per the practice prevailing in JNPT, Navi Mumbai area. For conducting e-Auctions, the tenderer would have to upload the details of longstanding cargoes together with their container numbers on their website and conduct e-Auctions through a proper software in such a way that the bidders identity is unknown to anybody else from the start of the e-Auction to its closing time so as to maintain proper fairness and accountability of the auction process. The software should also be such that the prospective bidders can give their bids from all over India on the web site easily during the time of e-Auction and should have access to the last highest bid amount for a particular lot and without having any access to the last bidder's identity.

At the close of the e-Auction the selected Tenderer must be in a position to furnish immediately an authentic hard copy print out of the final bid-sheet duly signed by them. The final bid sheet must contain against respective e-Auction lots the names & address of the highest bidder with their bid amount apart from other relevant details as per the prevailing practice in this JNPT area.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility Criteria For Techno-Commercial Bid

- a) Payment of Interest Free EMD of Rs. **[5,000/-]** *MSMED/NSIC Parties are exempted from payment of EMD.*
- b) Bidder should be register vendor with Balmer Lawrie & Co Ltd Container Freight Station, Dronagiri, Navi Mumbai or any other unit of Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd.
- c) Bidder should have at least three year experience in conducting e-Auctions and Tender-cum-eAuction and valuation of cargo for any CFS in JNPT, Navi Mumbai area or for Customs in Mumbai or Navi Mumbai. .Copies of the work order or completion certificate should be submitted.
- d) Bidder should have GST Registration number.
- e) Average Turn over of . Not less than Rs. Three Lakh during the last three financial years ending on 31.03.2018. Supporting documents regarding turnover i.e. Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss A/c. or certificate from Chartered Accountant.
- f) Bidder should not be black listed by any PSU or Govt Institutions . Self-declaration for the same should be provided by bidder.

2. Submission Of Online Bids

The bids should be submitted in single bid process

Technical / Commercial Bid [Unpriced] with Price bid

For Price Bid, only the rates are to be submitted as per given format.

3. Tender Opening

Unprice and price bid will be opened online as per tender calender .

4. Acceptance of offers

4.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part or reject any tender or all tenders or place order for any quantity, less than or more than the tendered quantity, without assigning any reason thereof.

4.2 Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest is detected between the bidders and Balmer Lawrie at any stage.

4.3 Balmer Lawrie also reserves the right to split the supply order between two or more agencies if necessary; such a step shall not form the basis for alteration of rates.

4.4 Balmer Lawrie is not bound to accept the lowest rate for any tender. Balmer Lawrie also reserves its right to allow Public Enterprises (Central / State) price / purchase / contract / service preference as admissible under the existing Government policy. The decision of Balmer Lawrie in this connection will be final.

4.5 Incomplete tenders, conditional tenders, tenders received late or tender not conforming to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender documents or not accompanied by the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (unless exempted under the terms of this Tender) will be rejected.

5. Negotiations

5.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to negotiate with the Tenderer. Tenderer will have to attend the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie for negotiations/clarifications required from them, in respect of their quotations, without any commitment on the part of Balmer Lawrie.

5.2 In case of negotiation, the Tenderer should send the confirmation of outcome of such negotiation in writing so as to reach the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie within 3 days from the date of negotiation/ the time stipulated. If the Tenderer fails to comply with this requirement Balmer Lawrie reserves its right to ignore their quotation at its discretion with the attendant remedies available to them.

6 Price Variation

6.1 The price should be firm and irrevocable and not subject to any change whatsoever even due to increase in cost of materials, components and labour cost till the validity of the contract period.

6.2 The quoted rates shall be valid for a period of minimum 60 days from the date of opening the price Bid.

7 Notification Of Award

Prior to the expiration of the period of Bid validity, BL will place purchase order or letter of indent on the successful bidder(s).

8. Contract Period

The contract will be for a period of **[12 months effective from date of issue of LOI /WO]** or such date as may be mutually agreed.

9. Security Deposit / EMD

The Earnest Money Deposit of the successful bidder would also be retained as Security Deposit till completion of the contract period. The EMD of unsuccessful bidder shall be returned after finalization of the contract.

10. Payment Terms

Payment would be released by cheque within 15 days of submission of bidders invoice mentioning clearly the successful e-Auction and Tender cum e-Auction & valuation conducted over a month and giving calculations of their share of service charges. The GST on the service charges would be paid additionally on furnishing GST registration number together with a certified copy of GST registration certificate.

11. Service Charges

The Service Charges for auctioneering would be calculated on the Customs accepted e-Auction value or Tender cum e-Auction value excluding taxes and duties for those longstanding goods which are finally lifted by respective highest bidders after making full payment to Balmer Lawrie CFS. In case of unsuccessful e-Auctions or Tender cum e-Auctions, no Service Charge would be payable. However, where an e-Auction or Tender cum e-Auction is successfully completed and the final bidder fails to take ultimate delivery of the cargo and the payment made by the successful bidder is forfeited, the selected tenderer will get the calculated percentage of service charge on the amount so forfeited. The Service charges for valuation would be calculated as indicated in Price Bid .

12. Liability

The selected tenderer will be fully responsible to keep BL-CFS indemnified in case of any liability arising/claim being made on Balmer Lawrie due to any fault attributable to the tenderer for the conduct of e-Auction and Tender cum e-Auction and valuation.

13. Periodicity of Auction

Approximately one or two e-Auctions and Tender cum e-Auctions would be required to be conducted every month. This is only an indication and does not carry commitment..

14. Sub-letting of Work

No part of the contract or any share or interest therein shall in any manner or degree be transferred, assigned or sublet by the contractor directly or indirectly to any person, firm or corporation without the consent in writing from Balmer Lawrie. In the event of contractor contravening the conditions, Balmer Lawrie shall be entitled to get the work done from other firm at the 'Risk & Cost' of the contract.

15. Indemnity

The Contractor will be required to indemnify and keep indemnified the Company against all losses and claims for injury and damage to any person or any property whatsoever which may arise out of or in consequence of the work and against all claims, demands proceedings damages, cost charges and expenses whatsoever. The company may forward the bidder any such claim demand or complaint made by any other person against the company. In such event, the contractor shall solely be liable for the disposal of

the said complaint. The contractor will be required to Indemnify and absolve the Company of all responsibilities related to employment condition of their employees and should adequately safeguard Company against any possible IR problems including those related to employment. The bidder should adhere to all State and Central Enactments related to employment such as Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Provident Fund Act, Employees State Insurance Act, Gratuity Act, Bonus Act, Contract Labour [Regulations and Abolition] Act etc. Further, Company will not have any liability towards employment, remuneration or compensation in whatever manner made to the employee of the bidder. Such demand shall be settled by the bidder directly.

16. Termination

The contract can be terminated by either party by giving 3 clear months notice in writing. However in case of serious breach of contract by the Contractor the Company reserves the right to terminate the contract without notice.

17. Arbitration

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Kolkata to a sole arbitrator appointed mutually under the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final and binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at Kolkata will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract.
