#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

#### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

#### A. Type of Vehicle

- A.1 The vehicle should be used for Ambulance purpose only. The vehicle should have valid registration for commercial use.
- A.2 The Vehicle should have required safety provisions and it should be properly maintained and seat cover should be neat and clean.
- A.3 The vehicle offered for hiring should not be more than 5 years old at the time of contract period with excellent condition and with a maximum run of 50,000 kms.
- A.4 The vehicle offered should have valid comprehensive insurance, valid PUC Certificate, Fitness certificate issued by RTO on the date of tendering.
- A.5 The vehicle should be serviced as per OEM's specifications and a Service Book should be available wherein details of services availed should be mentioned.

#### B. On Driver:

- B.1 Driver engaged by the service provider must hold valid commercial license for driving passenger vehicle since last 5 years.
- B.2 Since service to be rendered on 24x7 basis, 2 drivers to be deployed on 12 hour shift basis for each driver.
- B.3 The service provider must provide clean uniform with shoe to the driver, but under no circumstances BL Logo or name should be displayed on the uniform.
- B.4 The Driver must be covered under ESI scheme. In absence of ESI coverage, the service provider must take insurance policy covering risks similar to ESI scheme.
- B.5 As per the Road safety guideline, the driver should not use mobile phone while driving the car. However, in case of emergency, the vehicle should have hand free device for holding the mobile.
- B.6 The service provider must provide an undertaking that the Drivers provided by him do not suffer from colour/night blindness along with the tender.

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B.7 Driver should not be allowed to drive under the influence of any intoxicant or Liquor.

#### C. Role of Service Provider:

- C.1 The service provider must submit Name, address, copy of Driving License and police verification report of the driver engaged. Driver should not be changed without prior approval of BL and the Documents as stated above of the new Driver should be made available to the company before such deployment. All statutory compliance with respect to the driver engaged should be complied.
- C.2 The Service Provider must indemnify Balmer Lawrie against any liability arising out of the operation of this contract and for which BL is not responsible and for this purpose service provider must submit suitable indemnity bond acceptable to BL.
- C.3 The service provider must provide for fuel, lubricants and consumables including repair, statutory payment etc. and he will be responsible for proper upkeep and regular servicing of the hired vehicle.
- C.4 Service Provider must ensure that the log book is signed by the user.
- C.5 Service provider must be the owner of the vehicle bearing Commercial Registration. Information as per Format- 1 should be provided by the bidder.
- C.6 In case of breakdown of vehicle under contract, the service provider should arrange for replacement of similar type of vehicle immediately. In case the service provider/vendor is not able to provide such replacement, BL can hire vehicle from market and the amount paid/payable on account of such hiring will be recovered from the Service Provider.

#### 2. <u>Duty Timings & Related Terms</u>

- 2.1 (a) Balmer Lawrie has offices at the following locations:

Vehicle shall be required to report at any of the aforementioned offices at scheduled time mentioned above as directed by the company officer and shall be at the disposal of the company normally every day on 24x7 basis. The Ambulance will be stationed at the Unit indicated at 1(b) above.

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### 2.1 (b) Guidelines:

- a) The ambulance should be equivalent to Maruti Omni type vehicle atmost 5 years old, having proper registration and road validity certification and in good running condition.
- c) The ambulance should be fitted with First Aid box having prescribed contents, Oxygen cylinder with necessary mask, stretcher etc.
- **d**) The ambulance along with Driver be hired on 24x7 basis for a period of 2 year from the date of Contract with a provision for further extension of the contract by 1 year subject to satisfactory service and consent of both the parties.
- e) The contract can be terminated by Balmer Lawrie by giving notice of 3 months.
- f) Fuel cost for running the vehicle will be met by Balmer Lawrie based on a standard Mileage of 13 kms per litre of Petrol. Cost of petrol to be considered as on the last date of preceding month.
- g) All maintenance, replacement of spare parts, tyres etc. and other incidental cost including salary, PF, ESI etc. of the driver and other statutory related obligations have to be met by the bidder.
- **h)** In case of any accident, involving the ambulance, responsibility with regard to any penalty, litigation, compensation etc. will lie on the bidder.
- i) In case of any major repair, suitable provision of an alternative vehicle to be arranged by the bidder.
- **j**) The party has to ensure availability of one ambulance (24x7) of above specification in good running condition at any point in time.
- k) The vehicle will ply for atleast 2kms within BL premises on idle days.
  - 2.2 All the costs for running and maintenance of the vehicle shall be exclusively borne by the bidder, e.g. costs towards fuel (petrol/diesel), lubricants, maintenance, regular servicing, driver's salary, etc.
  - 2.3 The contractor shall be responsible for all payment to the operating drivers, besides providing uniforms, lunch / snacks etc.
  - 2.4 The contractor shall ensure that the vehicles provided are manned by qualified & experience driver with valid driving license issued by competent and designated authorities. The contractor shall engaged well behaved and honest driver with valid driving license.
  - 2.5 The contractor shall also procure appropriate valid permits, as may be required under the Motor Vehicles Act for running the vehicles. Consequences arising out of violation or non-adherence to Traffic rules shall be the responsibility of the contractor.
  - 2.6. The contractor shall be responsible for taking full comprehensive insurance policy for covering all risks, damages and loss arising out of the use of the vehicles, which would cover not only personal injuries to driver and the occupant of the vehicles, but also to third parties who may lodge a claim on account of any accidents. The Contractor should also abide by all statutory obligations regarding his employees. The company is not responsible for the insurance claim/ or claim of any sort.
  - 2.7 The contractor shall comply with the legal procedure in every aspect on all occasions and adhere to all statutory obligations in connection with running the vehicles on hire.

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- 2.8 In case of accidents resulting in any claim from the third parties, it shall be the responsibility of contractor to initiate or defend legal actions arising out of the use of the vehicles and payment of compensation, if any, to the third party and others who have a valid legal claim arising out of the accident.
- 2.9 The contractor shall be liable and responsible for all damages, losses, etc. sustained by his employee(s) while travelling in the car provided by the contractor arising out of any accident or otherwise in the said vehicle. The company shall not be liable for the same in any way.
- 2.10 The expenses on account of licenses, taxes, insurance, wages, fuel, repair and maintenance etc shall be borne by the contractor. In the event of necessity for a change of car during hire- time on account of break down/ accidents etc. the contractors shall ensure that substitute car in road-worthy condition is provided and running kilometer will be continued from the place of break-down.
- 2.12 In case of any breakdown, alternate arrangement will have to be made by the selected contractor by providing another suitable vehicle with driver at no extra cost, failing which the company shall arrange alternate vehicle at the risk and cost of the contractor and differential expenses incurred if any will be deducted from the monthly bill of the contractor.
- 2.13 The contractor shall arrange for payment of Parking Fees or Toll charges required in discharging the duties as and wherever required and shall get the reimbursement of the incurred amount on claiming the same.

#### 3. Special Condition

A gestation period of three (3) months may be allowed to the successful vendor for placing the Brand New Car. Mean while during initial three months period, the vendor shall have to provide equivalent Car having equivalent capacity in good running condition for executing the service as mentioned above.

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#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### 1. Eligibility Criteria For Techno-Commercial Bid

a) EMD of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) by Demand Draft/Pay Order at our above address. The DD/PO for EMD should be drawn in favour of BALMER LAWRIE & CO LTD on any Scheduled Bank, payable at [Kolkata].

[MSME/ NSIC registered vendors under micro and small category are exempted from submission of EMD]

- b) Should have executed similar orders with reputed organization in the last 2 years (PO to be enclosed).
- c) Minimum average turnover of Rs.3.0 Lacs per financial year during last three years. (IT Return/Balance Sheet-P&L report/CA certificate to be submitted in this regard)
- d) PF and ESI Registration (copy to be attached).
- e) The bidder should not have been black listed in any of the PSU's or private organizations and a self-certification to this affect would need to provided on contractor's letter head. #### 2. Submission Of Online Bids

#### 3. Acceptance of offers

3.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part or reject any tender or all tenders or place order for any quantity, less than or more than the tendered quantity, without assigning any reason thereof.

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- 3.2 Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest is detected between the bidders and Balmer Lawrie at any stage.
- 3.3 Balmer Lawrie is not bound to accept the lowest rate for any tender. Balmer Lawrie also reserves its right to allow Public Enterprises (Central / State) price / purchase / contract / service preference as admissible under the existing Government policy. The decision of Balmer Lawrie in this connection will be final.
- 3.4 Incomplete tenders, conditional tenders, tenders received late or tender not conforming to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender documents or not accompanied by the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (unless exempted under the terms of this Tender) will be rejected.

#### 4. Negotiations

- 4.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to negotiate with the Tenderer. Tenderer will have to attend the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie for negotiations/clarifications required from them, in respect of their quotations, without any commitment on the part of Balmer Lawrie.
- 45.2 In case of negotiation, the Tenderer should send the confirmation of outcome of such negotiation in writing so as to reach the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie within 3 days from the date of negotiation/ the time stipulated whichever is earlier. If the Tenderer fails to comply with this requirement Balmer Lawrie reserves its right to ignore their quotation at its discretion and proceed to finalise the tender

#### 5. Price Variation & Validity Period of Offer.

- 5.1 The price should be firm and irrevocable and not subject to any change whatsoever even due to increase in cost of materials, components and labour (due to minimum wages and other statutory compliances) till the validity of the contract period.
- **6.** The schedule of rates shall be all inclusive consolidated rates for providing the vehicles, cost of experienced drivers, consumables such as fuel, lubricants, tools & tackles.
  - 6.1 The quoted rates shall be kept valid for acceptance for a period of minimum 120 days from the due date of submission of the tender.

#### 7. Notification Of Award

Offers would be evaluated for entire Price schedule.

Prior to the expiration of the period of Bid validity, BL will place purchase / work order or letter of intent on the successful bidder(s).

#### 8. Contract Period

The contract will be for a period of Two (2) years. If the successful vendor is new to BL, then the contract shall be awarded for a trial period of three months effective from the date of placing of vehicle as per tender terms which on satisfactory performance shall be extended for the balance period.

# 9. Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit

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Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit for ₹10,000/- [Rupees Ten Thousand only) has to be submitted in the form of a Pay Order/DD, as per prescribed format of the Company, to cover the "Risk & Cost" of any damages caused due to negligence/ mishandling of equipment/property of the Company. Security Deposit to be detained by BL till end of the Contract period and will not bear any interest.

#### 10. **EMD**

The bidders should submit an Earnest Money of ₹.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) in the form of Pay Order/Demand Draft drawn in favour of BALMER LAWRIE & CO. Any failure on contractor's part and, if it warrants the Company to arrange an outside agency to get the work done, the same will be done on "risk & cost" of the contractor. The amount, incurred by Company on this account will be recovered from the contractor's bill along with claim for any other damage the company may incur. Additionally Rs.1,000/- would be deducted from the monthly bill per day basis in case of failure to provide vehicle as per scope of tender.

#### 12. Sub-letting of Work

No part of the contract or any share or interest therein shall in any manner or degree be transferred, assigned or sublet by the contractor directly or indirectly to any person, firm or corporation without the consent in writing from Balmer Lawrie. In the event of contractor contravening the conditions, Balmer Lawrie shall be entitled to get the work done from any other firm at the 'Risk & Cost' of the contractor/successful bidder.

#### 13. Indemnity & Ensuring Safety

- 13.1 The Contractor will be required to indemnify and keep indemnified the Company against all losses and claims for injury and damage to any person or any property whatsoever which may arise out of or in consequence of the work and against all claims, demands, proceedings, damages, cost charges and expenses whatsoever. The company may forward the vendor any such claim demand or complaint made by any other person against the company. In such event, the contractor shall solely be liable for the disposal of the said complaint.
- 13.2 The contractor will be required to indemnify and absolve the Company of all responsibilities related to employment condition of their employees and should adequately safeguard Company against any possible IR problems including those related to employment. The

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bidder should adhere to all State and Central Enactments related to employment, such as Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Provident Fund Act, Employees State Insurance Act, Gratuity Act, Bonus Act, Contract Labour [Regulations and Abolition] Act etc. Further, Company will not have any liability towards employment, remuneration or compensation in whatever manner made to the employee of the vendor. Such demand shall be settled by the vendor directly.

#### 14. Termination

The contract can be terminated by either party by giving 3 clear months notice in writing. However in case of serious breach of contract by the Contractor the Company reserves the right to terminate the contract without notice.

#### **15.** Force Majeure Conditions:

Delivery schedule is subject to force majeure conditions as under: If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock outs or acts of God (hereinafter referred as "events") provided notice of the happening of any such events is given by either party to the other within twenty one days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non performance or delay in performance. Deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable.

#### 16. Arbitration

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Kolkata to a sole arbitrator appointed mutually under the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final and binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at Kolkata will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract
