**1. Qualification**

  - c) One similar completed civil work costing not less than Rs. 5,00,000
- 3) Should have minimum average turnover of Rs.3,00,000/- during the last 3 years ending March 18.(Proof to be attached).
- 4) The Bidder must have GST registration (Proof to be attached)
- 5) Should not have been blacklisted by any PSU / Govt. Department (a self-certification is required and should be attached)

**4. Acceptance of offers**

- 4.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part or reject any tender or all tenders or place order for any quantity, less than or more than the tendered quantity, without assigning any reason thereof.
- 4.2 Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest is detected between the bidders and Balmer Lawrie at any stage.
- 4.3 Balmer Lawrie would like to place order for all the items of work as mentioned in the Price bid to a single contractor. The overall L1 status will be determined by looking at the total value quoted by the bidder.
- 4.4 Incomplete tenders, conditional tenders, tenders received late or tender not conforming to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender documents or not accompanied by the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (unless exempted under the terms of this Tender) will be rejected.

**5. Negotiations**

5.2 In case of negotiation, the Tenderer should send the confirmation of outcome of such negotiation in writing so as to reach the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie within 3 days from the date of negotiation/ the time stipulated whichever is earlier. If the Tenderer fails to comply with this requirement Balmer Lawrie reserves its right to ignore their quotation at its discretion with the attendant remedies available to them.



**6. Price Variation**

6.1 The price should be firm and irrevocable and not subject to any change whatsoever even due to Increase in cost of materials, components and labour cost till the validity of the contract period.

6.2 The quoted rates shall be valid for a period of minimum 30 days from the date of opening the price Bid.

**7. Notification of Award**

Prior to the expiration of the period of Bid validity, BL will place purchase order or letter of intent on the successful bidder(s).

**8. Safety**

The bidders are strictly advised to follow the various safety aspects as per HSE norms in attending to the above work at various elevated structures, roof levels like providing proper scaffolding, safety ropes and safety helmets, safety shoes etc. Under no circumstances Balmer Lawrie would be liable for any kind of deviation in following the safety instructions by the bidder. It is contractor's responsibility to obtain necessary PTW (Permit To Work) from concern officers before start any work.

**9. Completion Period**

The entire work shall be supplied within 6 weeks from the date of placement of order.

**10. EMD**

**13. Sub-letting of Work**

No part of the contract or any share or interest therein shall in any manner or degree be transferred, assigned or sublet by the contractor directly or indirectly to any person, firm or corporation without the consent in writing from Balmer Lawrie. In the event of contractor contravening the conditions, Balmer Lawrie shall be entitled to get the work done from other firm at the 'Risk & Cost' of the contract.

**14. Declaration of UAM by MSME vendors**

**15 Liability & Ensuring Safety**

- c) Proper PPE usage has to be ensured

**16. Purchase preference policy for MSE Vendors**

If it is seen that a Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) has participated and the price quoted by them is within a price band of +15% of the L1 price (which is from a supplier who is not MSME), then such MSE vendor shall be allowed to supply a pre-determined portion of the tendered quantity subject to their matching the L1 price. In case, more than one number of MSE vendors are within the +15% range, all of them shall be given the option of matching the L1 price. In such a situation, the pre-determined quantity shall be equally divided amongst all such MSME vendors who have matched the L1 price. **17. Compliance of GST**

The vendor should compulsorily follow all the provisions of GST and in the event any default for fulfilling any provisions of the GST Act, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. would exercise the right for non-payment/withholding payment, / black listing the vendor.

**18. Indemnity**

**20 Arbitration**

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Kolkata to a sole arbitrator appointed mutually under the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final and binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at Kolkata will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract.
