1.2 Digital Certificate authentication

The bidder shall authenticate the bid with his Digital Certificate for submitting the bid electronically on e-procurement platform and the bids not authenticated by digital certificate of the bidder will not be accepted on the e-procurement platform.

2. Special Note

- Bids can only be submitted before the last date and time of submission as per the date and time mentioned in the e-tender. Resubmission (if required) of bid should be completed within the stipulated date and time. The system time (IST) that will be displayed on e-tendering web page shall be the time and no other time shall be taken into cognizance.
- Bidders are advised in their own interest to ensure that bids are uploaded and submitted successfully in e-tendering system well before the closing date and time of bid.
- No bids will be accepted physically or by post.
- Balmer Lawrie does not take any responsibility in case bidder fails to upload the documents within specified time of tender submission.
- Balmer Lawrie will not be responsible for any delay under any circumstances for non-receipt of any documents sent by post as part of response to the tender. Bidders are requested to provide correct "e-Mail address" and "Mobile No." for receiving updates related to e-tender from time to time.
- The bidder has to keep track of any changes by viewing the Addendum/Corrigendum issued by the Tender Inviting Authority on time-to-time basis in the e-Procurement platform. The Company calling for tenders shall not be responsible for any claims/problems arising out of this.

3. Filling of Tender Documents

- 3.1 The tenderers are requested to carefully study all the tender documents and tender conditions before quoting their rates.
- 3.2 The tender must be strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions and specifications laid out in the tender.

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- 3.3 Any terms and conditions given by the tenderer on his own in their offers will not be binding on Balmer Lawrie.
- 3.4 The sole proprietor or authorised representative shall sign all documents that needs to be uploaded. When the person signing the documents is not the sole proprietor / authorised representative of the company, the Power of Attorney authorizing such person to act and $\frac{1}{2}$ sign on behalf of the company must be scanned and uploaded and produced later on for verification by Balmer Lawrie.

SCOPE OF WORK

Work covered in this tender document shall generally be as detailed in BOQ and outlined herein below. However, contractor shall be responsible to complete the work in all respects and in doing so provide/supply all facilities which may not be explicitly covered below /BOQ but nevertheless are required to complete the work envisaged with the exception of only such items as have been specifically excluded from contractor's scope.

A general scope of work is follows:

- In totality 10000 MT ± 10% break bulk cargo to be removed from Port and unloaded at CFS 1.
- 2. Take loading of cargo from Vessel hook point.
- 3. Transportation for cargo from Kolkata Port to Balmer Lawrie (BL) CFS-Kolkata
- 4. Documentation for entering trailers inside Port premises and taking the load.
- 5. For smooth removal from dock to CFS removal, min 50 nos. of 40 feet trailers, out of which 20 nos. of 40 feet trailers should be on the hook point so that hook point should not be idle at any point of time, and 30 nos. The Vehicles should continuously perform loading /unloading operations.
- Ensure to affix Mild steel poles (Angles or solid pipes) on the 4 ends and also angles on the middle in the trailers so as to load break bulk cargo (pipes & others) in trailers safely. If required lashing is to be done properly through lashing belt and steel chain in 4 ends from front to end
- It will be the endeavour of the transporter to load every trailer with maximum allowable 8. weight of the cargo as per Govt. of India Norms
- 9. To comply to basic safety norms & ensure safe passage from Port to CFS.
- 10. Dock liaison to ensure prompt delivery to trailers from Port for faster removal
- 11. All dock liaision and related expenses are to be borne by the transporter
- 12. All trailers immediately after unloading from CFS should report to Dock for taking further load
- 13. Hook detention [if any] for non-presence of trailers at loading bay will be on transporter account

- 14. All trailers should comply with the Port norms to ensure non hassle free entry and exit of trailers from Port premises
- 15. BL will not pay any detention charges for Vessel idling in case there is any break or change of shift or any other reason not under BL's control.

16. The trailers should have wooden reusable blocks along the breadth of the trailer bed on two ends so that the pipe are kept on that and there is space to slide slings for unloading. The blocks should be strong enough to bear load. At the edge of the wooden blocks wedge shaped block to be there so that the pipes do not role.

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1.0 **Job Description**

Transportation of Pipes& other break bulk cargo directly from Vessel Hook Point at Kolkata Port [KDS] to our Container Freight Station located at P-3/1, Transport Depot Road, Kolkata – 700 088 or transportation from CFS to Port[KDS]

2.0 Requirement of Trailers

The bidder should be well known transporter or fleet owners having good reputation and track record of carrying Cargo/Containers to and from Ports. At least 80% of required number of trailers are to be placed as per our requirement at 2 hours notice. In case of failure to place the adequate number of vehicles as per our requirement, Balmer Lawrie shall be at liberty to arrange for vehicles at the Risk & Cost of the successful bidder. The difference amount, if any, shall be deducted from the transport contractor's bill. The driver of the vehicle and supervisory staff should be present all the time while loading / unloading at Kolkata Port and P-3/1, Transport Depot Road.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility Criteria For Techno-Commercial Bid

- a) Deposit of Earnest Money of ₹10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) online along with the bid. However, MSME/NSIC bidders are exempted from submission of EMD subject to their submission of relevant Certificate. MSE Vendor should declare UAM number on CPPP (Central Public Procurement Portal) failing which such bidder will not be able to enjoy benefits as per PP Policy for MSMEs order 2012..
- b) Submission of Trade License.
- c) Bidder has to provide proof of ownership of 50 nos of 40 feet trailes and 10 nos. of 20 feet trailers. All the trailers have to be in the name of the company or in the name of any of the Directors of the company. No attached trailers will be allowed for this job. The RC copy and the insurance of the 50 trailers have to be Uploaded/submitted with the tender document.
- d) Working experience of Transportation of containers/cargo (minimum 3 years) in KDS.
- e) Minimum average turnover of ₹1.00 Crore(One Crore) per financial during last three financial years.
- f) Registration Certification with GST.
- g) The bidder should not have been black listed in any of the PSU's or private organizations and a self-certification to this affect would need to be provided on contractor's letter head. The company may verify such certification and if found during such verification that the statement is not true, the bid of the party will be rejected without any further reference to them.

2. Submission Of Online Bids

The bids should be submitted in the form of a single bid consisting of both qualification documents and price in our e-procurement website.

The entire bid is to have digital signature of the person having Power of Attorney/Power of Authority $\frac{1}{Page \mid 8}$ to sign on behalf of the Bidder.

3. Tender Opening

Tender will be opened as per the tender calnedar

4. Acceptance of offers

- 4.1 Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part or reject any tender or all tenders or place order for any quantity, less than or more than the tendered quantity, without assigning any reason thereof.
- 4.2 Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest is detected between the bidders and Balmer Lawrie at any stage.
- 4.3. Balmer Lawrie would like to place order for all the items of work as mentioned in the Price bid to a single bidder. The overall L1 status will be determined by looking at the total value quoted by the bidder based on the estimate quantity against a line item as given in the tender document multiplied by the rate quoted by the bidder.
- 4.4 Balmer Lawrie also reserves its right to allow Public Enterprises (Central / State) price / purchase / contract / service preference as admissible under the existing Government policy. The decision of Balmer Lawrie in this connection will be final.
- 4.5 Incomplete tenders, conditional tenders, tenders received late or tender not conforming to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender documents or not accompanied by the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (unless exempted under the terms of this Tender) will be rejected.

5. Negotiations

- a. Balmer Lawrie reserves the right to negotiate with the L1 Tenderer only. Tenderer will have to attend the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie for negotiations/clarifications required from them, in respect of their quotations, without any commitment on the part of Balmer Lawrie.
- b. In case of negotiation, the Tenderer should send the confirmation of outcome of such negotiation in writing so as to reach the concerned office of Balmer Lawrie within 3 days from the date of negotiation/ the time stipulated whichever is earlier. If the Tenderer fails to comply with this requirement Balmer Lawrie reserves its right to ignore their quotation at its discretion and proceed to finalise the tender.

6. Price Variation

- 6.1 The price should be firm and irrevocable and not subject to any change whatsoever even due to increase in cost of materials, components and labour cost till the validity of the contract period.
- 6.2 The quoted rates shall be kept valid for acceptance for a minimum period of 90 days from the last date for submission of tender.

7. Notification of Award

Prior to the expiration of the period of Bid validity, BL will place purchase/work order or letter of intent on the successful bidder(s).

8. Rate

The rate should be quoted inclusive of all such Charges for Handling or any other incidental/miscellaneous charges incurred at port and no charges will be reimbursed/paid. The offer should be strictly as per the prescribed format given in the Price Schedule. Rates to be quoted as per Price Bid Schedule attached. Rates

quoted shall be inclusive of all duties & charges except for GST which shall be paid by BL extra as applicable and as per Govt. norms from time to time. The rate should be kept firm during the period of contract.

9. EMD

The bidder should submit Earnest Money of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) online only. EMD of unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded without interest after finalization of the $\frac{1}{2}$ contract, EMD of successful bidder shall be converted into part of the Security Deposit or else shall be refunded after receipt of full SD money.

EMD is liable to forfeiture in the event of:

- a) Withdrawal of offers during validity period of the offer
- b) Non acceptance of orders by the bidder within the stipulated time after placement of order.
- Any unilateral revision made by the bidder during the validity period of the offer. c)
- d) Non submission of Security Deposit.
- Bidders submitting false/fabricated/bogus documents in support of their credentials e)

10. Validity of the Offer

The rate Offer should be kept valid for acceptance for 90 days from the last date for submission of the tender.

11. Contract Period

The contract would be for a period of one [1] year from the date of issuance of LOI/Work Order whichever is earlier. Their will be an option to increase the contract period by one [1] more year only on mutual consent with the existing rates, terms and conditions

12. Payment

Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of submission of monthly bills duly certified by Officerin-charge of the Company. All taxes and duties as applicable will be deducted from the bills as per rules in force from time to time. The contractor has to ensure that all statutory and other requirements as demanded by BL have been duly complied with before submission of bills.

13. Volume Of Work

Generally these are Project Cargo imported by our various clients and the Volume of work through this contract depends absolutely on prime clients of Balmer Lawrie & Co Ltd which may arise during this contract period. No guarantee of volume can be assured.

14. Security Deposit

The successful bidder shall deposit within seven days from the date of Letter of Intent (LOI)/Work order whichever is earlier a sum equal to 5% of the contract value by way of Demand Draft in favour of BALMER LAWRIE & CO. LTD. payable at Kolkata as Security deposit. Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format, issued by Scheduled Commercial Bank can also be accepted by the company in lieu of the deposit. The Bank Guarantee is to be valid for a period of One year and three months. On extension of contract by one [1] year

The Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited or appropriated towards any penalty imposed by BL as a result of acts of omission/commission/gross negligence on the part of the contractor or towards any charges like demurrage, damage to the container/cargo that may become payable by Balmer Lawrie to its customers or failure of the successful bidder to execute the work as per terms and conditions of the contract without prejudice to the other right or action that the Company is entitled to. The Security Deposit after adjustment, if any, may be refunded to the contractor after successful completion of the contract and after settlement of all dues. No interest shall be payable on the security deposit.

During tenure of the agreement, in the event of forfeiture of full or part of security deposit or encashment of part/full amount of the Bond, the contractor shall make good of the amount within 15 days on receipt of notice from the Company.

MSE bidders will have to submit security deposit as per the clause.

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15. Penalty/Liquidated Damages

For missing hook point due to non-placement of vehicle and damaging the goods customer

- a. Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited or appropriated towards any penalty imposed by BL as a result of commission/gross negligence on the part of the contractor, or towards any charges like demurrage, damage to the container/cargo that may become payable by Balmer Lawrie, or failure to execute the work as per terms and conditions of the contract without prejudice to execute other right, or action by the company.
- b. The amount if not recoverable from the security deposit will be recovered from the bill for this particular job or from the bills related to any other job the successful bidder is already doing with Balmer Lawrie & Co Ltd in present or future

16. Insurance

The contractor should take necessary insurance for their vehicles but not limited to third party liability. It is further clarified that in case of any accident through their vehicle, the contractor shall be liable to BL or any third party for any loss/damage for cargo or person.

In case of any shortage/damage/loss to goods for whatsoever reason while the same are in the custody of the contractor, the contractor shall be liable to make good the value of goods including duty, penalties and fines as are leviable by the appropriate authority for such damage/shortage/loss. The fleet owner should have a Carrier's Legal Liability cover for all the vehicles that are engaged in transportation of container & cargo contained therein for Balmer Lawrie-CFS (from Port to CFS & vice-versa). The limit of indemnity in this policy should cover Rs. 1.00 lac AOA and Rs. 4.00 lacs AOY (1:4) for loss / damage to container/cargo and Rs.5.0 crore's AOA and Rs. 5.0 crore AOY (1:1) for loss/damage to cargo contained in the container.

A copy of such policy is required to be provided to BL-CFS.

17. Labour Law

The Contractor shall comply with all the provisions of all labour legislations of the State/Central Government or any competent authority as applicable in respect of all men/women employed by them in executing the contract. The contractor shall be responsible to defend cost and expenses whatsoever arising out of any failure on the part of contractor to comply with all or any of the Acts and Regulations, of all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, cost and expenses whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the matters referred to in this tender. Coverage of ESIC/WC for operator/helper to be undertaken by contractor copy of which is to be provided to Balmer Lawrie (BL)-CFS, failing which BL will deduct at the applicable rate of ESI contribution from contractor's bill and the same will be deposited with the concerned Authority.

Contractor shall be responsible to settle all the disputes with Workmen engaged by them. Contractor shall indemnify and absolve the Company of all responsibilities related to employment condition of their employees and should adequately safeguard Company against any possible IR problems including related

to employment. Notwithstanding the above the contractor should adhere to all employment regulations such as Minimum Wage Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, Provident Fund Act, Gratuity Act, Employees State Insurance Act, Bonus Act and/or any other legislation as is in force and as applicable in respect of this tender, etc.

The Company will not have any liability towards employment, remuneration or compensation in whatsoever manner against demand made by the employees of the contractor and such demand be settled by the contractor directly.

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Contractor will ensure that the services rendered is discharged without any hindrance and blockage and no other charges/demand for payment are levied on the Company for the services rendered other than the fixed rates as covered in this tender.

18. Termination

- a. In the event of repeated instances of unsatisfactory service or any failure at any time on the part of the contractor to comply with the terms and provisions of this contract to the satisfaction of Balmer Lawrie and company Limited (BL)(who shall be the sole judge and whose decision shall be final), it shall also be open to BL to terminate this contract by giving not less than (15) fifteen days notice in writing to that effect and if the contractor, does not make good his default within the notice period, BL shall be entitled to terminate the contract as a whole or in part and also make suitable deductions from the running bill towards short service / unsatisfactory service rendered by the contractor.
- b. In the event of such termination of the contract, BL shall also be entitled to:

 (i) forfeit the Performance guarantee as it may consider fit; (ii) get the balance/remaining work done by making alternative arrangements as deemed necessary and until such time BL is able to appoint a new regular Contractor; and recover from the contractor (appointed under this tender) any extra expenditure incurred by BL in getting the work done and damages which BL may sustain as a consequence of such action.
- c. If the extra expenditure incurred by BL on account of unsatisfactory performance of the contractor as mentioned in paragraphs above is more than the Performance Bank Guarantee proposed to be forfeited, the expenditure over and in excess of the Performance Bank Guarantee may be recovered by deducting the said amount from pending bills of the contractor under this tender or from money due to the contractor by BL under this or any other contract or otherwise. The contractor shall have no claim whatsoever against BL, in consequence on such recoveries or termination of the contract, as stated above.
- d. The certificate of BL Official, as to the sum payable to the new agency, if the work in question had been carried out by him under the terms of contract, shall be final and binding on the contractor.
- e. If at any time the contractor becomes insolvent or files an application for insolvency or any creditor of his moves the court for adjudicating him as an insolvent or, if he is convicted by any court of law, BL will have the absolute option of terminating the contract forthwith and he shall have no right for damages or compensations on this account.
- f. BL will have the liberty to terminate the contract by giving an advance notice of (30) thirty days without assigning any reason. .

19. Liability & Ensuring Safety

The Contractor will be fully responsible for ensuring safety of lives, cargo, vehicles, property and containers within KoPT, CFS/Empty Container yard where jobs under scope of this contract are being carried out by them . Any damage to any life and/or property therein as mentioned due to

negligence/mishandling of vehicle by the Operator and /or malfunctioning of the vehicle would be to the account of the contractor. It is mandatory that necessary 3rd party insurance cover is kept valid by the contractor for the vehicle used under this contract.

20. Force Majeure Conditions:

Delivery schedule is subject to force majeure conditions as under: If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock outs or acts of God (hereinafter referred as "events") provided notice of the happening of any such events is given by either party to the other within twenty one days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non performance or delay in performance. Deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable.

20. Arbitration

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred for adjudication at Kolkata to a Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman & Managing Director, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. and the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the Arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties.
