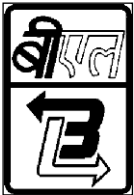

- 4.0 The rates should be quoted in the same units as mentioned in the tender schedule of quantities.
- 5.0 All entries in the tender documents should be in ink / type. Corrections if any should be attested by full signature of the tenderer.
- 6.0 Every page of the tender document including annexure / enclosures shall be stamped and signed by the tenderer or his authorized representative thereby indicating that each and every page has been read and the points noted.
- 7.0 Items of work provided in this Schedule but not covered in the Specifications shall be executed strictly as per instructions of the Engineer-In-Charge.
- 8.0 The Quantities of the various items mentioned in the Schedule of Items are approximate and may vary up to any extent or be deleted altogether.
- 9.0 Engineer's decision shall be final and binding on the Contractor regarding clarification of items in this Schedule with respect to the other sections of the Contract.

Special Notes :

- (i) *Basic Wages, PF and ESI percentage rates are pre-filled and cannot be changed by the bidders. However, any changes in percentage of PF & ESI contribution shall be applicable during the entire course of contract. While bidders shall fill up L.S rates in Sl. No. (iv), percentage of Contractor's margin should be given in percentage (%) in Sl. No.(vi).*
- (ii) *Bidders should quote monthly rate for Safety Officer under table 1.2. Such monthly rate shall be inclusive of PF, ESI (if applicable), Workmen Compensation, other statutory & non-statutory allowances and contractor's profit.*
- (iii) *Successful bidder/contractor must comply with payment of Minimum Wages for all categories of labour. Such payments shall be verified at the time of processing of bills.*
- (iv) *The price Bid format shall be duly filled up, signed and stamped by the bidder prior to uploading to BL's E-procurement site.*
- (v) *The priced bid shall not be part of the techno-commercial offer for any reason whatsoever.*
- (vi) *Applicable GST charges shall be paid as extra.*
- (vii) *The above rates for working all days on 8 hour-shift basis and inclusive of probable expenses for taking care of local issues, any hidden cost whatsoever, any other prevailing Govt. levies.*
- (viii) *The Minimum wages mentioned in the Price Bid have been derived from the order F No. 1/20(3)/2020-LS-II dated 12.10.2020 issued by the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Office of the Chief Labour Commissioner(C), New Delhi. In the event of any revision in minimum wages through notification by Govt. of India/State Government or by CPCL authority whichever is higher for Contractor's labourer, the differential amount along with incremental payment on PF & ESI & contractor's margin will be reimbursed to/deductible from the contractor's bill. However, monthly wages for Safety Officer shall remain same through the contract period. The contractor can claim the revised amount with proof of Govt. notification/CPCL's circular etc.*
