SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work shall consists of

- a. Repair of all the Automatic insulated doors which includes replacement of heaters, push button, pull chord, fixing of handles, roller guards, sensors, rubber gaskets etc., to ensure that all the doors are repaired properly and should work in auto mode after the repair. The alignment of all the doors are also required to be checked and to ensure that all the doors are properly sealed for any leakages.
- b. Repair of Insulated Panel joints wherever the joints are opened. The Alu Tap has to be applied properly at the joints to prevent the heat leakages from inside the chambers.
- c. Repair of all sectional doors for auto operations which should include all the spares etc. complete.
- d. Providing and fixing the Door Opening buzzer along with lights for all the chamber doors. The provision should be made in the plant room.
- e. Providing and fixing hatch door as per BOQ in the frozen doors.
- f. Providing and fixing SS Door Sill four no chilled chambers.
- g. Checking and verifying and making good all the pressure release valves for its proper functioning.

Note: - The bidder has to make a though inspection of all the doors before quoting the rate for the subject work.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility Criteria for Techno-Commercial Bid

floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock outs or acts of God (hereinafter referred as "events") provid21.ed notice of the happening of any such events is given by either party to the other within twenty one days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance. Deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable.

19. Arbitration

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of **Kolkata** to a sole arbitrator to be appointed mutually by the Parties and the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. - "Class-II local supplier" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services or works offered for procurement, has local content mare than 20% but less than 50%, as defined under the Order.
- "Non Local supplier" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services or works offered for procurement, has local content less than or equal to 20%, as defined under the order.
- "L1" means the lowest tender or lowest bid or the lowest quotation received in a tender, bidding process or other procurement solicitation as adjudged in the evaluation process as per the tender or other procurement solicitation.
- "Margin of purchase preference" means the maximum extent to which the price quoted by a *Class-I local supplier' may be above the L1 1or the purpose of purchase preference.
- "Nodal Ministry" means the Ministry or Department identified pursuant to this order in respect of a particular item of goods or services or works.
 - B. For implementation of the above order following mechanism will be adopted for operating Purchase preference under this Tender enquiry:
- "All the item/s of this Tender will be considered as **non-divisible** and following procedure will be adopted for operating Purchase Preference"

- Among all qualified bids, the lowest bid will be termed as L1.
- If L1 is Class-I local supplier, the qty will be ordered as per clause no 9 (Notification of Award– page no 13) under General Terms and Conditions.
- If L1 is not from a Class-I local supplier, the lowest bidder among the Class-I local suppliers, will be invited to match the L1 price if their price is within 20% band of the L1 price in order of bid price from lowest to highest
